Dear Church Family,

These are busy times at Corinth Baptist Church. On Tuesday, our School Time Bible ministry starts again at New Ellenton Middle School. Already, we've nearly doubled our enrollment. Praise the Lord! And pray for God to transform the lives of these children as they learn from His word about the gospel of Jesus.

Next month, we begin our Revival services led by Len Turner and Loose Stone. As I personally prepare myself for revival, God has led me to share the following meditation:

"In those days ten men from nations of every language shall take hold of a Jew, grasping his garment and saying, 'let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.'"
- Zechariah 8:23[NRSV]

I must ask myself *"when have I ever seen that kind of inquiry from nonbelieving seekers in my lifetime?"* Sadly, I don't think I've ever experienced that extensive of a manifestation of God's work in a church and I've been to some very moving and inspiring revival meetings - even protracted ones. However I'm doubtful that genuine revival is occurring if the outside world sees no marked change in the people of a church. We might piously remark that we had *"wonderful revival service"* but they see through such religious jargon.

Revival won't occur unless God shows up through the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. We need to begin now in prayer that God will show up and show out through His people. Here is a suggested prayer to guide us as we personally and collectively pray for revival:

Prayer: Oh to have a genuine Holy Ghost Revival O God! We desire a revival in which lives are so manifestly transformed that outsiders want to encounter our God and shamelessly show up hungry for the same experience with You, O God! God, based not upon our merit but upon Your character, send a great revival to your flock and let it begin in me. Amen.
